



## 2002 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir

The Russian River Valley appellation of Sonoma County is the cradle of fine Pinot Noir. Produced from three of our finest vineyards, our Russian River Pinot Noir represents the depth, complexity & elegance of this world-famous region. Overflowing with fresh plum, dark cherry & raspberries this wine runs deep with vanilla bean, cedar & spice with undertones of shitake mushrooms & hints of smoke. Although drinkable now, this wine will only get better in your cellar.

The final blend for our 2002 Russian River Pinot Noir is comprised of three vineyards. This wine is produced mainly from Cohn Vineyard with the balance coming from Koplen Vineyard on Olivet Road and Kanzler Vineyard, two miles south of the Russian River border.
