Our flagship wine comes from the Cohn Vineyard in the Russian River Valley. Rich in history, this 38 year-old vineyard produces small quantities of intense fruit.

The 2001 Cohn Vineyard Pinot Noir is deep, complex and intense from start to finish. Overflowing with luscious dark cherry, cassis, raspberry and blueberry. The bold intensity envelopes the classic Russian River terrior. Hints of sweet chocolate and cedar are integrated throughout the many layers of this wine. Although drinkable now, this wine is truly meant for the cellar.
