Our most vibrant Pinot Noir, the 2001 Sonoma Coast is reminiscent of the wines of Burgundy.

Aromas of cherry, violets and orange peel fill the nose. Focused acidity frames the elegant structure of cherry and strawberry with a hint of coffee. The silky mouthfeel leads to finish of bright fruit and supple tannins.
